Networking

60 to 70% of all positions are filled this way.

Find someone who knows someone in the organization or call someone you know in the organization

Direct Contact

Write directly to the executive or manager generates meetings (interviews)

Search firms

If you are looking for a position similar to the one you are currently working then search firms that specialize in your area can help you find interviews

Advertising

Companies and organizations advertise in newspapers, publications and internet websites.

Job Fairs

Companies looking for many positions will join a job fair many of the job fairs specialize in what they are looking for.
