How do you create a home page?

You don't have to hire an expensive consultant, designer, or typographer. The easiest way is to find a page you like, copy it, and modify it for your own style and content.

Before you begin, you'll need a:

- word processor or text editor
- graphics editor and conversion tool
- web browser
- Internet service provider to host your page
- Step 1. Find someone's page that you like.
- Step 2. View the source file (the HTML).
- Step 3. Save the source file with "Save As..." to your disk.
- Step 4. Edit the file to add your own content and graphics.
- Step 5. Check spelling.
- Step 6. Preview your page to check graphics and links.
- Step 7. Upload your page.
- Step 8. Tell people about it.
- Step 9. Keep it fresh.

Within each document:

- Sign and date it
- Give links into context—don't say "click here"
- Have a good title
- Use a banner or icon graphic as a theme to give identity to your pages
- Keep in mind that all browsers don't support graphics, use ALT="text"
- Keep in mind that not all users have fast connections and high resolution monitors
- Keep in mind that low-end computers don't support sound and video
- Test your pages on a variety of browsers
